



KENNESAW MOUNTAIN TO CHATTAHOOCHEE RIVER (KMCR) TRAIL "GAP" SECTION

TRANSPORTATION ENHANCEMENT PROJECT

FACT SHEET

BACKGROUND

The City of Marietta was awarded federal, Transportation Enhancement Program, grant funds to construct the Kennesaw Mountain to Chattahoochee River (KMCR) Trail "Gap" Section. The KMCR "GAP" Trail is a 2 year project that will provide citizens with a multi-use trail from West Atlanta Street to Fairground Street via East Dixie Avenue and Larry Bell Park. The proposed work consists of new sidewalks/pedestrian paths, landscape improvements at the intersection of Atlanta Road and East Dixie Avenue, and other pedestrian improvements and amenities. The length of the trail is 3,900 linear feet of 8' to 10' wide sidewalk from West Atlanta Street to Fairground Street.

This phase of the overall City Trail System will connect West Atlanta Street to an existing trail located on the west side of Fairground Street. The purpose of this trail project is to install a "Gap" Trail to connect the Marietta Square and Kennesaw Mountain National Battlefield Park to the north with the universities trail to the east. Once the "Gap" Trail is complete, citizens will have direct access to other federally funded trails, from the Kennesaw Mountain Trail in the north to the Chattahoochee River Trail in south Cobb County.

The total cost of the "Gap" Trail project is \$1,338,959 of which \$400,000 is covered by federal Transportation Enhancement (TE) funds. The anticipated completion date of the project is Fall 2014.


