Marietta Fire Department Experiences Loss of One of Their Own

It is with great sadness that the Marietta Fire Department announces the tragic loss of one of its own. Fire Fighter Engineer Lonnie Nutt succumbed to a medical issue he experienced and collapsed during a call while rendering aid to an injured motorist.

At approximately 4:30pm on March 7, 2013, the Marietta Fire Department responded to an automobile accident with a report of injuries on Whitlock Ave. A Fire Commander and Firefighter on Engine 53 were being driven to this emergency scene by Fire Fighter Engineer Lonnie Nutt. When they arrived on the scene and began to assist with the injured patient, Fire Engineer Nutt fell to the ground with a medical issue of his own. Firefighters from Marietta began diligently rendering care and assisted Metro Ambulance with transport to Kennestone Hospital. Fire Engineer Nutt succumbed to his medical issue after arriving at the hospital.

Lonnie Nutt began his career with the City of Marietta in May of 1994. He has served Marietta as a Fire Fighter, Inspector, Investigator, and currently Firefighter Engineer. The entire Marietta Fire Department Family will greatly miss Fire Engineer Lonnie Nutt.
