

Hunter Walk

Hunter Walk is a collection of single-family homes located in the Roswell Street Renaissance District. The majority of homes are located on Waterman Street approximately three-quarters of a mile from the Marietta Square and one mile from the Hilton Atlanta/Marietta Hotel & Conference Center and City Club golf course.

Project details

Hunter Walk's craftsman-style homes are constructed on traditional single-family lots on Coryell Drive and Waterman Street. Most homes include garages and feature hardwood floors, granite countertops and other high-quality finishes and fixtures.

Project history

The 2005 takeoff of redevelopment in the Roswell Street Renaissance District beginning with the development of Village at Frasier Park and Manget at Historic Marietta inspired the building of upscale single-family homes on existing lots. A small builder began to purchase homes in the area for demolition and infill development. The builder called his collection Hunter Walk after longtime Marietta City Councilwoman Betty Hunter, who grew up and still lives in the district.
