### **Community Interaction**

The Community Response Unit (CRU) assisted with the following events during the month.

### **Specialized Units – Detectives/Narcotics/Crime Interdiction**

Specialized units within Marietta Police Department contribute to the success of each zone. It is the responsibility of each unit supervisor to have teams work within zones that may have increased activity over the previous months.

- Four narcotics cases opened within the City of Marietta
- Sixteen arrests were made within the City for drug offenses
- During the month the Narcotics Unit seized no weapons
- Detectives opened seventy two cases, served nine search warrants, and worked several cases including but not limited to:
  - Burglary
  - Robbery
  - Armed Robbery
  - Theft by Taking
  - Loitering/Prowling
  - Prostitution
  - Criminal Trespass
  - Forgery/Theft
  - Battery/False Statements
  - Obstruction/False Report
  - Murder/Suicide
  - Reckless Conduct
  - DV – Battery
- Terroristic Threats/Misuse of 911Crime Interdiction Unit made five arrests.
