Specialized Units – Detectives/Narcotics/Crime Interdiction

Specialized units within Marietta Police Department contribute to the success of each zone. It is the responsibility of each unit supervisor to have teams work within zones that may have increased activity over the previous months.

- Eleven narcotics cases opened within the City of Marietta
- Thirteen arrests were made within the City for drug offenses
- During the month the Narcotics Unit seized one weapon
- Detectives opened one hundred six cases, served seven search warrants, and worked several cases including but not limited to:
 - Child Molestation
 - Probation Violation
 - Burglary
 - Theft
 - Theft by Taking
 - Enticing a Child/Sexual Battery
 - Robbery
 - Damage to Property
 - Armed Robbery
 - Reckless Conduct
- Crime Interdiction Unit made twenty four arrests.
