Specialized Units – Detectives/Narcotics/Crime Interdiction

Specialized units within Marietta Police Department contribute to the success of each zone. It is the responsibility of each unit supervisor to have teams work within zones that may have increased activity over the previous months.

- Six narcotics cases opened within the City of Marietta
- Six arrests made within the City for drug offenses
- During the month the Narcotics Unit seized five weapons
- Detectives opened seventy cases, closed eighty one cases, served fifteen search warrants, and worked several cases including but not limited to:
 - Theft
 - Burglary
 - Murder
 - Wanted Person Located
 - Obstruction/Aggravated Assault/Kidnapping
 - Child Molestation
 - Bank Robbery
 - Parole
 - Rape
 - Public Indecency
 - Cruelty to Children
 - Aggravated Assault
- Crime Interdiction Unit made eight arrests.
