Specialized Units – Detectives/Narcotics/Crime Interdiction

Specialized units within Marietta Police Department contribute to the success of each zone. It is the responsibility of each unit supervisor to have teams work within zones that may have increased activity over the previous months.

- Eight narcotics cases opened within the City of Marietta
- Fourteen arrests made within the City for drug offenses
- During the month the Narcotics Unit seized one weapon
- Detectives opened one hundred three cases, closed one hundred cases, served eleven search warrants, and worked several cases including but not limited to:
 - Motor Vehicle Theft
 - False Report of a Crime
 - Child Abuse
 - Aggravated Child Molestation/Unruly Child/Contributing to the Delinquency/Enticing a child
 - Aggressive Driving/Racing
 - Theft by Receiving Stolen Property
 - Burglary
 - Aggravated Assault
 - VGCSA
- Crime Interdiction Unit made thirty two arrests.
