### **Specialized Units – Detectives/Narcotics/Crime Interdiction**

Specialized units within Marietta Police Department contribute to the success of each zone. It is the responsibility of each unit supervisor to have teams work within zones that may have increased activity over the previous months.

- Four narcotics cases opened within the City of Marietta
- Eleven arrests made within the City for drug offenses
- During the month the Narcotics Unit seized two weapons
- Detectives opened eighty-three cases, closed eighty-three cases, served eleven search warrants, and worked several cases including but not limited to:
  - Terroristic Threats
  - Theft by Receiving
  - Aggravated Assault
  - Armed Robbery/Shooting
  - Child Molestation
  - Cruelty to Child
  - Obstruction
  - Runaway Juvenile
  - Aggravated Stalking
  - Motor Vehicle Theft
- Crime Interdiction Unit made fifteen arrests.
