Any home is susceptible to lightning strikes that can cause surges to enter your home through your electrical meter, phone line or cable/satellite line. These surges can often destroy your appliances, computers, TVs, and any other valuable electrical device.

Marietta Power and Water's surge protection program helps protect your



expensive electrical equipment and major appliances against damage due to power surges or lightning strikes through your devices. If lightning does happen to get through any of the suppressors, destroying them, you don't have to worry. Your appliances will be repaired or replaced.\*

To qualify you must be a Marietta Power and Water residential electric customer living in a single-family home that is individually metered (no grouped meter installations); have proper grounding — improper grounding must be corrected by a licensed electrician; and the entry points for cable and telephone must be located within five feet of the electric meter


This years line up includes:

equipment). Customers receive protection of up to \$50,000 for repair or replacement per incident and up to \$5,000 per item. Well and pool pumps are covered if wired to main electric panel. ✨
