

Marietta Power and Water will pay rebates for energy audits, duct sealing, air sealing, and/or insulation installation to Marietta Power and Water residential electric customers in single-family homes. Rebates are paid by a one-time credit to your Marietta Power and Water bill. The home performance audit is required to be eligible

Save Energy and Money with the Appliance Rebate Program

Marietta Power and Water is also offering rebates to replace existing HVAC units and appliances with ENERGY STAR® certified central heating and air-conditioning equipment and ENERGY STAR® certified appliances.

HVAC Rebates:

- \$250 for gas to ENERGY STAR® electric unit
- \$100 for electric to ENERGY STAR® electric unit
- \$150 for new home installation of ENERGY STAR® electric unit

Appliance Rebates:

- \$10 for Water Heater Blanket (R-6 or greater)
- \$25 for Freezer
- \$30 for Programmable Thermostat

- \$30 for Room Air Conditioner
- \$50 for Clothes Washer
- \$50 for Dishwasher
- \$50 for Refrigerator (old refrigerator must be removed)
- \$250 for Heat Pump Water Heater

Rebates are available for Marietta Power and Water residential electric customers in single-family homes and are paid by a one-time credit to your Marietta Power and Water bill.
