BEWARE OF UTILITY PAYMENT SCAM PROMISING TO PAY YOUR BILL IN EXCHANGE FOR PERSONAL INFORMATION


Marietta Power and Water is cautioning our customers about a nationwide scam in which identity thieves are contacting utility customers claiming that a special federal government assistance program is providing credits or applying payments to utility bills in exchange for personal information such as social security numbers. Payments are not being applied to utility accounts and Marietta Power and Water is not contacting customers requesting any personal information including usernames and passwords to online accounts.

The scammers are stating that the Obama Administration has a program to pay utility bills on a one-time basis. Victims are asked to provide their social security number to apply for the program and are given a bank routing number to use when paying their bills online.

How to Protect Yourself

Don't provide any of your personal information to anyone claiming to be from Marietta Power and Water. If you receive a suspicious email, don't click on any links accompanying the communication or respond in any manner.
