



Pay Your Bills from The Comfort of Your Home or Office Anytime, Day or Night

Marietta Power and Water's online payment and pay-by-phone payment options give you the power to spend more time and money on things other than paying your utility bills.

Pay Your Bill Online



To pay your bill online, visit www.mariettapowerandwater.com and click on Customer Service, then Pay Your Bill. Once you're on the Online Payment System page, enter your user ID and password under User Login. If you do not have an account, click Create Account in the sidebar on the left.

You'll need your Account Number and Cycle and Route Number to create an account. After completing this simple set-up process, you can log into Marietta Power and Water's Online Payment System anytime, day or night, all year round. In addition to paying bills, you will have access to your electric and water consumption, billing amounts, and payments — as far back as three years.

eBilling Notification

If you would like to receive your bill electronically, sign up for Marietta Power and Water's eBilling notifications. Go to the Marietta Power and Water website at www.mariettapowerandwater.com and click on Customer Service and Pay Your Bill. Once you're on the Online Payment System page, enter your user ID and password under User Login. Click on Manage eBilling on the left side of your computer screen. Select the Receive eBill statement option, enter your email address and click submit. That's it! You'll be receiving your next bill via email.

Pay-By-Phone

You can also manage your account using Marietta Power and Water's Pay-By-Phone option. Simply call Marietta Power and Water at (770) 794-5150 and select the "Make Utility Payment by Phone" option from the list of menu options you hear. Follow the prompts and enter your Marietta Power and Water account number and the credit card number that you wish to use to pay your bill. The system will accept VISA, MasterCard, Discover and American Express cards for payment for residential customers. When you finish, the system will immediately process your payment and provide you with a confirmation number. Stop wasting your time and money on writing checks, stuffing envelopes, buying stamps, and running back and forth to the post office. Put Marietta Power and Water's Online Payment System or Pay-By-Phone option to work for you. 💧

Lower Your Energy Bill While You are Away

Planning a vacation this summer? Here are a few tips to save money and lower your energy bill while you are away.

Electronics. Unplug all electronic devices before you leave. Digital displays can continue to use energy whether you are at home or not.

Water heater. Lower the temperature setting while you are away and conserve heat loss.

Air conditioner. Set your thermostat higher in
