





Marietta Power and Water Proudly Presents Our Annual Water Quality Report

Water is important to all of us — its availability, its quality, and its use. Marietta Power and Water remains vigilant in meeting the goals of source water protection, water conservation, and community education while continuing to serve the needs of all of our water users. We also continually strive to adopt new methods for delivering the best-quality drinking water to you.

The Marietta Power and Water annual Water Quality Report is available to all our customers online at <https://www.mariettaga.gov/City/media/Docs/PowerWater/ccr2015.pdf>, and details all of the drinking water testing that was performed between January 1 and December 31, 2015. Our water is continually monitored for quality control and assurance, both at the treatment plant and in the distribution system. Each year thousands of water samples are taken to monitor for substances such as pesticides, herbicides, microbial, organic and inorganic contaminants. This monitoring confirms, once again, that your water supply meets or exceeds all state and federal drinking water standards.

The Water Quality Report includes information about lead and copper monitoring. Because of low levels of lead and copper historically found in our service area (and an associated low level of risk for lead and copper contamination), the Cobb County –Marietta Water Authority and Marietta Water are required to submit samples collected at customer taps to the state only once every three years. The next round of sampling is scheduled for 2017. Additional information
