# Georgia Law

Effective July 1, 2018


## WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW ABOUT THE NEW LAW

The new law means you cannot drive a vehicle while holding a cell phone or supporting a cell phone with any part of your body.


### Hands Free Law

1. A driver may not hold/support a wireless telecommunications device or stand-alone computer with any part of their body.  


-Exceptions: Earpiece, headphones, smart watch  



2. May not write, send, or read any text-based communication. 

-Exceptions: Automatic voice-to-text

3. Navigation/GPS can be viewed while driving as long as it is not being  held/supported with any part of the driver's body.

4. A driver may not watch a video. 

5. A driver may not record a video. 

6. At no point while the vehicle is being operated can a driver use ANY apps to include social media and music.
