

SPRAYGROUND RULES

- . Children under 12yrs old MUST be supervised by someone at least 16yrs of age.
- . All children under the age of 3 years (or older children requiring them) MUST wear an approved swim-diaper, and they MUST be changed regularly.
- . Swim suits and/or appropriate attire must be worn always by all visitors.
- . Soft-soled water shoes/sandals are strongly recommended.
- . Persons should not use the sprayground if they are suspected of having a communicable disease, diarrhea, or have exposed tissue, blisters and/or cuts.
- . All users must conduct themselves in a safe, courteous, and welcoming manner.
- . Running, horseplay, and undue disturbances are prohibited.
- . Do not climb or hang on any of the sprayground equipment
- . Drinking, spitting, and spouting of water from mouth/nose is not allowed.
- . Sprayground must be used for its intended purpose only. Bathing is not allowed.
- . Athletic equipment, beach balls, noodles, inflatable & water toys are prohibited.
- . The use of profane language will not be tolerated.
- . Skateboards, roller blades, bicycles, and scooters are not allowed.
- . Pets are prohibited, except service animals which are allowed on the dry deck only.
- . Consumption of food/drinks is not allowed in the painted sprayground area.
- . Glassware is not allowed anywhere in the park.
- . Alcoholic beverages are strictly prohibited.
- . Tobacco products and e-cigarettes are strictly prohibited.
- . At first sign of thunder and lightning, vacate the sprayground area, and seek shelter
- . Amplified music is prohibited.

The sprayground may be closed for maintenance, health conditions, weather, or any other reasons deemed necessary.
