## **43<sup>rd</sup> Annual HarvestFest 2019 Arts & Crafts Exhibitor Application**

### **ABOUT THE SHOW**

HarvestFest is an annual Arts and Crafts Festival held each October in Glover Park at Historic Marietta Square. The festival will be sure to please the whole family! In addition to a wide variety of arts and crafts items, the festival will also include Halloween Happenings for children from 1:00 PM to 5:00 PM. Carnival games and lots of prizes will thrill the little ones. The highlight of Halloween Happenings is the annual costume contest at 2:00 PM. There's fun for animal friends with our Pet Costume Contest too. Scarecrows on the Square will invade the usually bird-friendly park again!

The Square is home to many antique and specialty stores, excellent restaurants and interesting things to do. Our local history is recounted at the Marietta History Museum just off the Square in the historic Kennesaw House. The Marietta Fire Museum is located just 2 blocks from the Square on Haynes Street. The museum houses historical fire equipment and several older vehicles including the 1879 steam powered engine, the Aurora. The Marietta/Cobb Museum of Art is also located just off the Square. The museum has an excellent permanent collection and hosts traveling exhibitions.

### **APPLICATION PROCEDURES AND FEES**

- Exhibitors must complete, sign and return applications by the **September 20<sup>th</sup> deadline**.
- Payment for booth space is due at the time application is submitted. Enclose booth fee with check made payable to City of Marietta or provide eligible credit card information. Credit charge will show on your statement as a charge to Marietta Board of Lights and Water. Application fees will be processed and deposited as received.
- Choose exhibitor category and booth size.
- Submit four photos, no slides, to your application. Digital computer copies are acceptable. Photos should show an overview of the display, one showing you at work and your studio/work area and two of your art/craft. Please format/cut your pictures to fit in the appropriate spaces on the application. All previous participants are required to send photos as well.
- **Accepted applicants will receive notification of acceptance with their booth number the week of September 30<sup>th</sup>.**
- Withdrawals should be made in writing and must be received by October 4<sup>th</sup> to be eligible for a refund.

### **GENERAL PARTICIPANT INFORMATION**

- All work must be made and displayed by the artist. No preformed ceramics, imports or wholesale items for resale!
- Participants must provide their own tables, tents, etc. for their booth set up. Booths must be weighted down.
- Load-in and set-up is Saturday morning 5:30 AM-8:30 AM. Break-down and load-out is 5:30 PM-7:00 PM.
- All displays must be set up and all cars removed from the festival area by 8:30 AM on Saturday. For the safety of the shoppers and exhibitors, vehicles may not be brought into the festival area until the end of the show. Anyone not following these instructions will not be allowed in the show again.
- Exhibitors are responsible for collecting and paying Georgia taxes and any other taxes. Collecting names for a mailing list is permitted.
- A signed application constitutes a commitment by the exhibitor to participate and follow all festival rules.

*\*MPRD reserves the right to reject or remove from the show any work it considers unsuitable. All photos become the property of Marietta Parks, Recreation and Facilities.*
