The City of Marietta and the Board of Lights and Water position allocations chart and position classification and compensation plans for the 2012 fiscal year.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARIETTA, GEORGIA, THAT:

<u>Section 1:</u> The position allocation chart, marked "Exhibit A", attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference, is amended to include the reclassification of the Operations Manager to Assistant Public Works Director/Operations Manager; reclassification of the Sanitation Superintendent to Environmental Services Manager; reclassification of the Training and Safety Coordinator to the Public Works Analyst/Safety Coordinator; and the deletion of the Sanitation Supervisor. These changes are effective upon approval by council for the 2012 fiscal year and shall replace any allocation chart previously adopted.

Section 2: The position classification and compensation plans, marked "Exhibit B", attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference, are amended to include the reclassification of the Operations Manager to Assistant Public Works Director/Operations Manager; reclassification of the Sanitation Superintendent to Environmental Services Manager; reclassification of the Training and Safety Coordinator to the Public Works Analyst/Safety Coordinator; and the deletion of the Sanitation Supervisor position, effective for the period of 12:01 a.m., November 7, 2011 to 12:00 midnight on June 30, 2012. These plans shall replace any position classification and compensation plans previously adopted.

<u>Section 3:</u> It is hereby declared to be the intention of this Ordinance that its sections, paragraphs, sentences, clauses, phrases and words are severable, and if any section, paragraph, sentence, clause, phrase or word of this Ordinance is declared to be unconstitutional or invalid, it shall not affect any of the remaining sections, paragraphs, sentences, phrases or words of this Ordinance.

Section 4: All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict with the Ordinance are hereby repealed.

<u>Section 5:</u> This Ordinance shall become effective upon the signature or without the signature of the Mayor, subject to Georgia laws 1983, 4119.
