

AN ORDINANCE

To provide for an amendment to Code Section 2-6 – Fire Prevention and Protection

NOW THEREFORE, THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARIETTA, GEORGIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. The Code of Marietta, Georgia, Section 2-6-160 is hereby amended and shall read as follows:

2-6 -160 - FIREWORKS

- A. Adoption by reference O.C.G.A. § 25-10-1 through 25-10-10 of that chapter known as the Regulation of Fireworks are adopted as and for the fireworks regulations of this municipality with like effect as if recited herein. If any provisions of the Regulations of Fireworks, as adopted herein, is declared unconstitutional or invalid, it shall not affect the remaining sections of that chapter.
- B. A permit, for a distributor selling consumer fireworks from either a retail sales facility or retails sales stand, must be obtained from the Fire Department, per O.C.G.A. § 25–10–5.1.
- C. Any person who violates this section shall, upon conviction, be punished in accordance with Section 11-4-080 of this Code, as now or hereafter amended.

Section 2. It is hereby declared to be the intention of this Ordinance that its sections, paragraphs, sentences, clauses and phrases are severable, and if any section, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance is declared to be unconstitutional or invalid, it shall not affect any of the remaining sections, paragraphs, sentences, clauses or phrases of this Ordinance.

Section 3. All Ordinance or parts of Ordinances in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall become effective upon the signature or without the signature of the Mayor, subject to Georgia laws 1983, page 4119.




