ORDINANCE NO: 7904

AN ORDINANCE

To provide for an amendment to Code Section 10-6 - Noise

NOW THEREFORE, THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARIETTA, GEORGIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. The Code of Marietta, Georgia, Section 10-6-020 is hereby amended to add the following:

10-6-20-Definitions.

Fireworks is any combustible or explosive composition or any substance or combination of substances or article prepared for the purpose of producing a visible or audible effect by combustion, explosion, deflagration, or detonation, including blank cartridges, firecrackers, torpedoes, skyrockets, bombs, and other combustibles and explosives of like construction, as well as articles containing any explosive or flammable compound and tablets and other devices containing an explosive substance.

The Code of Marietta, Georgia, Section 10-6-050 is hereby amended to add the following:

10-6-050 – Restricted uses and activities.

H.

Fireworks use and ignition and or explosion are lawfully allowed: where a person 18 years old or older, is lawfully allowed on the site of use and ignition and or explosion on any day from 10 AM up to and including 9 PM, additionally on January 1st, July 3rd, July 4th, and December 31st, after 9 PM up to and including 11:59 PM, on January 1st, from 12 midnight to 1 AM.

Section 2. It is hereby declared to be the intention of this Ordinance that its sections, paragraphs, sentences, clauses and phrases are severable, and if any section, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance is declared to be unconstitutional or invalid, it shall not affect any of the remaining sections, paragraphs, sentences, clauses or phrases of this Ordinance.

Section 3. All Ordinance or parts of Ordinances in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall become effective upon the signature or without the signature of the Mayor, subject to Georgia laws 1983, page 4119.


