


The Friends of Brumby Hall host **Step Back in Time, Life In the 1860's** at Brumby Hall and Gardens



Step back in time and experience history when you tour Brumby Hall and Gardens, a lovely Greek revival-style house built in 1851 by the Georgia Military Institutes' first superintendent, Colonel Arnoldus V. Brumby. While touring the home you will hear the history of how the house was used as a military hospital in 1864 and will hear stories from the day. Learn how the house was spared in Sherman's infamous "March to the Sea."

Historians and reenactors will represent life in the mid 19th century with demonstrations of weaving, sewing, military life, playing dulcimers and children's games.
