


2013 NeighborScapes Tree Grant Application



Marietta Tree Keepers is a non-profit, volunteer organization dedicated to planting, preserving and protecting trees in and around the city of Marietta, Ga. Our main strategy is to educate the public about trees including their selection, planting and maintenance. We emphasize the benefits that trees have for our community including reducing air and noise pollution, cooling the air, conserving energy and water, reducing soil erosion, enhancing wildlife habitat and greenspace, not to mention raising property values.

Marietta Tree Keepers would like to award a grant of up to \$1,000 (10 + trees) to a neighborhood in the City of Marietta. The grant will help neighborhoods plant or replant their street canopy by planting trees on private frontage property. Applications chosen will be installed during the month of October 2013.

Eligibility Requirements

1. Properties must be located within the Marietta city limits
2. Properties must be residential
3. Tree planting location must be on private property
4. Limit one tree per property
5. Each application must contain a proposal from at least three (3) and no more than ten (10) properties/neighbors.
6. Neighbors must be located within three hundred feet (300') of each other in order to be listed on the same application
7. Tree planting location on individual lots must be within the front or major side yard (if located on a corner).
8. Applicants agree to participate in the installation of the tree on their property
9. Options are limited to the suggested tree species listed on the following page.

Application Deadline is **May 30th, 2013**. Please submit a completed application by this deadline in order for your application to be considered by the Application Evaluation Team. Winners will be announced **July 15th, 2013**. Applications may be submitted in two ways:

Agreement and Acknowledgement

By signing below, each applicant agrees to and acknowledges the following if this application is chosen:

1. The final location and species will be chosen by a determination team made up of qualified landscape architects, arborists, and /or foresters. This team will take into consideration the location of structures, trees, utilities, and other site features prior to selecting the location and species of the tree.
2. Each neighbor will be responsible for having the utility lines marked prior to both the visit by the determination team and the day of installation. A request to have lines marked should be made at least 48 hours prior to the event by calling 811 or 1-800-282-7411.
3. Each neighbor will be responsible for participating and/or being present on the day of installation.
4. Each neighbor will be required to sign a tree planting and maintenance agreement.
5. Each neighbor will be responsible for checking with or obtaining approval with any applicable homeowner's associations prior to application submittal.
6. The trees will be installed during the month of October 2013.
