Level Three: Consideration for a level three response may be based on three to four street closures and/or this event has a history of criminal activity and/or drawing large crowds.	\$950 per hr.
Level Four: Considerations for a level four response is based on the number of street closures and high-profile events such as July 4th and New Years' Eve.	\$1,270 per hr.

Ex.: Kiwanis Club, Rotary Club, Lions Club, Junior Service Leagues, American Legion, Optimists Club, etc.

Class C: Private Resident Groups

These are local resident groups, either adult or youth, with a membership that is comprised of at least fifty percent (50%) Cobb County residents.

Ex.: Sports teams and organizations comprised of less than 75% but more than 50% Cobb County residents, religious groups, HOA's, alumni groups, neighborhood associations, etc.

Class D: Non-resident Groups

These are groups that do not meet the qualifications of Class A, B or C, but are not commercial in nature or fund-raising groups.

Ex.: Groups who are not comprised of a minimum of 50% Marietta City residents.

Class E: Commercial Groups or Fund-Raising Groups

These are groups interpreted to be commercial, in nature non-recreational, or any of the above groups utilizing facilities for fund-raising purposes.

Ex.: Profit-making organizations, seminars, trade shows, etc.

- a. B.E.R.T. - Shall consist of two EMT-I(minimum training level), two bicycles equipped to handle Basic Life Support calls (including AED). The BERT teams will operate in teams of two. The fee shall be \$75.00 per hour, per team and includes all associated equipment.
- b. Rescue (ALS) – Shall consist of two personnel, one of which will be a Paramedic. The crew will be able to provide Advanced Life Support (ALS). The fee shall be \$100.00 per hour and includes personnel and all associated equipment.
- c. Engine/Truck – Shall consist of a minimum of two personnel and will be equipped to handle BLS calls. The fee shall be \$125.00 per hour and includes personnel and all associated equipment.
- d. Honor Guard – Shall consist of a minimum of 4 individuals, the number needed to properly present the “colors.” All needed equipment will be furnished by MFD. The fee shall be a minimum of \$100.00 per person (\$400.00) for the first 4 hours and \$25.00 per hour, per person, for each hour after that.
