Applicant, Christopher Brink, is seeking approval to demolish the existing chimney structure and replace with a new chimney constructed of red brick in the same shape and location as the existing chimney. The existing chimney has been inspected and found to be in very poor condition. The goal being to maintain the historic appearance of the residence while constructing a chimney that will operate safely.

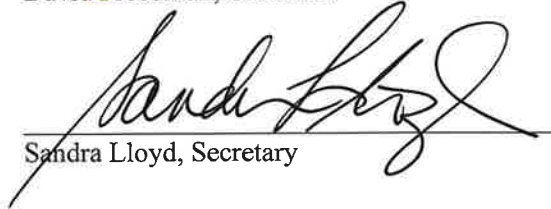
