



TITLE VI POLICY STATEMENT


The City of Marietta/BLW is committed to compliance with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 and all related regulations and directives. The City of Marietta/BLW assures that no person shall on the grounds of race, color, national origin, as provided by Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 and the Civil Rights Restoration Act of 1987 (P.L. 100.259), be excluded from participation in, be denied the benefits of, or be otherwise subjected to discrimination under any program or activity. The City of Marietta/BLW further assures every effort will be made to ensure nondiscrimination in all of its programs and activities, whether or not those programs and activities are federally funded. In addition, the City will take reasonable steps to provide meaningful access to services for persons with Limited English Proficiency.

When the City of Marietta/BLW distributes federal aid funds to another governmental entity, the City of Marietta/BLW will include Title VI language in all written agreements and will monitor for compliance.

The City of Marietta/BLW Department of Human Resources and Risk Management is responsible for initiating and monitoring Title VI activities, preparing required reports, and handling other City of Marietta/BLW responsibilities as required by 23 Code of Federal Regulations (CFR) 200 and 49 Code of Federal Regulations 21.
