Specialized Units – Detectives/Narcotics/Crime Interdiction

Specialized units within Marietta Police Department contribute to the success of each zone. It is the responsibility of each unit supervisor to have teams work within zones that may have increased activity over the previous months.

- Nine narcotics cases opened within the City of Marietta
- Thirteen arrests were made within the City for drug offenses
- During the month the Narcotics Unit seized nine weapons
- Detectives opened ninety five cases, served nine search warrants, and worked several cases including but not limited to:
 - Burglary
 - Rape/Child Molestation
 - Robbery
 - Aggravated Assault/Battery
 - Armed Robbery
 - False Statements
 - Motor Vehicle Theft
 - Theft
 - Cruelty to Child
- Crime Interdiction Unit made twenty four arrests.
