Specialized Units – Detectives/Narcotics/Crime Interdiction

Specialized units within Marietta Police Department contribute to the success of each zone. It is the responsibility of each unit supervisor to have teams work within zones that may have increased activity over the previous months.

- Seven narcotics cases opened within the City of Marietta
- Ten arrests were made within the City for drug offenses
- During the month the Narcotics Unit seized seven weapons
- Detectives opened fifty eight cases, served fourteen search warrants, and worked several cases including but not limited to:
 - Armed Robbery
 - Theft by Taking
 - Theft by Deception
 - Loitering
 - False Report of a Crime
 - Battery
 - Exploitation of a Child
 - Burglary
 - Obstruction
 - Felony Murder

- Crime Interdiction Unit made forty eight arrests.
