Keep Your Household Budget on Track with Marietta Power and Water's Budget Billing Program

The change in seasons can sometimes mean an increase in your monthly power and water bill which can make it difficult to stay within a tight budget. Fortunately, through Marietta Power and Water's Budget Billing Program, you can also get more buying power for your utility dollar.

The Budget Billing Program is based on your average consumption of Marietta Power and Water services during the preceding 12-month period. Your monthly bill will reflect this average and remain the same for one year from the start date. On the anniversary of your enrollment, your bill will be recalculated for a possible new payment

amount and to settle up your budget billing according to your actual consumption.

In order to qualify, you must be a residential customer maintaining a satisfactory credit rating for twelve months. Participants are also required to commit to the program for one full year.
