

COUNCIL BILL NO. 331591

ORDINANCE NO. 4928

AN ORDINANCE

DEFINING the City's contribution rate toward retiree health insurance.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARIETTA, GEORGIA, THAT:

Section 1: All employees hired after passage of this Ordinance may continue their health insurance coverage after retirement from continuous, active service, but the retired employee must pay 100% of retiree and dependent calculated premium cost.

Section 2: No current terminated vested retiree nor any employee who will subsequently receive a terminated vested retirement benefit is eligible to receive health insurance benefits from the City of Marietta.

Section 3: It is hereby declared to be the intention of this Ordinance that its sections, paragraphs, sentences, clauses, phrases and words are severable, and if any section, paragraph, sentence, clause, phrase or word of this Ordinance is declared to be unconstitutional or invalid, it shall not affect any of the remaining sections, paragraphs, sentences, phrases or words of this Ordinance.

Section 4: All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section 5: This Ordinance shall become effective upon the signature or without the signature of the Mayor, subject to Georgia laws 1983, page 4119.
